# Chapter 1

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## *Behold the Lamb*

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What Christ the Lamb of God went through, who can adequately tell the story? How can it be told, this eternal multi-dimensional love story all the books in the world are not enough to tell! I sighed with wonder. It happened a few months ago in 2021 AD, as I traveled from Lagos Nigeria to Cotonou Benin in West Africa. Seated comfortably at the back of the vehicle as it raced through the countryside, a vision suddenly appeared. It was Christ the Lamb of God hanging on the Cross of Calvary! What a gory sight, who can describe it.

Fresh deep wounds covered His entire Body, from His head to His toes. Nowhere on His Body was spared! Like whipping the same

spot over and over again, all over His Body: Each strike inflicting concerning wounds out of which fresh Blood oozed out. Yet, they continued scourging Him throughout the night! What kind of whip did the Roman soldiers, supervised by Satan the devil, use! Whatever whip they used, the wicked men meant to inflict maximum damage, to completely mar His appearance: And they succeeded! The way the wounds were, the whip used could easily have been flexible slicing metal of some sought. Or it could have been several strong leather whips tied together into one whip. ## Chapter 2

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### *Who is Christ?*

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Whether in the body or out of it, in a night or day vision or trance, I cannot tell. But the window panels gently slid open to reveal the universe as it was before creation began. It was pitch black! Nothing. To say that it looked like the darkest night, could suggest that there was perhaps something like the light of day lurking somewhere. There was none. Light did not exist! To say it is like the darkness to be felt that once fell on ancient Egypt when God in heaven punished the gods of Egypt is to suggest that there could have been sights and sounds. There was none! No structures! No sound was

heard! No reason for air in the pitch blackness that was, since angels and mankind were not yet created. There was absolutely nothing! The darkness that fell on the ancient Egyptians was to be felt because it came with a type of heaviness. Nobody could move from that one spot where the heavy darkness caught them, for three whole days! Therefore, since no one could move in the darkness, it cannot be said that there was emptiness or space, for three whole days. Thoughts of formless thick and oily black cloudiness everywhere and nowhere; entered my mind. A thick black cloudiness Scripture calls waters, but not like water as is known on earth today (Exodus 10:21-23; Genesis 1:1).

Inside this thick and heavy pitch-black formless cloudiness, God the Everlasting Father was already existing alone inside! Somehow existing alone because the Holy Spirit revealed that the Everlasting Father Himself cannot recall how He came to be existing alone in the pitch-black cloudiness (1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 2:10)! The thick pitch-black cloudiness is His covering, like a dress or hiding place. Covered or wrapped in the pitch-black

eternal waves of clouds, so thick, that the most fervent prayers cannot pass through even by chance: The prophets, created later on lamented (Lamentations 3:44). Existing contentedly alone, the Everlasting Father moved about by riding this thick pitch-black oily cloudiness, like a chariot (Psalm 18:9-11, 104:3; 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 6:1). "Like a horse galloping happily alone on the street of eternity,' the Holy Spirit likened it. At this point in the eternal past, both our Lords the Holy Spirit and Christ the Lamb of God had not yet been born by the Everlasting Father!

According to our Lord the Holy Spirit: Realizing Himself existing alone in the pitch-black thick oily cloudiness He was covered in, the Everlasting Father God came to a gradual halt and became thoughtful. Thinking back, Father God could not recall how Himself was born, or how He came to be moving contentedly in existence alone! He looked everywhere and discovered He existed alone in the pitch-blackness: then He declared the truth, "I am the Lord. There is no God besides Me" (Isaiah 45:5-6). It was the moment Father God discovered in Himself a desire not to

continue existing alone in the pitch-black cloudiness, that the history of the universe began. In Himself, by Himself, and for Himself, Father God decided to have a family He would exist and dwell with. The Everlasting Father decided alone, since there was no one else, to have a household of innumerable sons: All like Himself, populating the entire universe of heavens and earth He would create and build. This way, the Everlasting Father planned to fill the entire universe with Himself, and be everything in it, through His family of innumerable sons resembling Himself. Why did God reach this eternal decision? For the pleasure of existing and dwelling with His family members forever in the eternal future, and no longer exist alone. Why did God reach this decision alone? Because there was no one else in existence with Him, to confer with. What further evidence is there that these revelations are so? Our very own existence, since we did not create ourselves! The Everlasting Father began thoughtfully implementing His decision. In His wisdom decided to have two unique Offspring through Whom His pleasure will be successfully

performed: The Holy Spirit and Christ the Firstborn Son.

This is the origin of the Holy Spirit, born and nursed to maturity by the Everlasting Father as the only Power in the universe to achieve His decision. The same Holy Spirit is the Everlasting Father's Helper like a wife to her husband, and Anchor for the only begotten unique Son He foresaw to have next. This is the origin of Christ the Lord. Christ is the only begotten Son of the Living God the Everlasting Father: First by mode of His birth, which is similar to the Holy Spirit but different from all other of the foreseen innumerable sons (*for detail, read the book, The Holy Spirit, 2022*). Second, by the purpose for His birth as the Original exactly like the Everlasting Father: Nursed by the Holy Spirit until everything the Father is, with the Holy Spirit, dwells fully in Him. He is the Pattern for all the other innumerable sons the Father desires to have, to be built to resemble. Therefore, Christ is the Firstborn among the innumerable holy sons the Father desires to have and dwell with forever. He is the center of everything the Everlasting Father desires to have. Through

Christ, the Everlasting Father will accomplish all His pleasure: Therefore, everything was and is created by Him, through Him, and for Him. Not a pin in the universe is created, except it is for Christ!! This means that without Christ, the Everlasting Father's plan will fall apart and the entire universe will be empty again! The Everlasting Father the Greatest will have to start all over again. Been therefore the main pillar or center of His entire plan, the Everlasting Father is both gentle and firm with the beloved Son He would never let stray from His Path to Glory.

It necessarily became Christ's glorious inheritance to serve as the King of kings over and among the innumerable holy sons of the Everlasting Father. ## Chapter 3

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### *Reciprocal Love*

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The Everlasting Father loves His Firstborn Son very much. A love-at-first-sight that comes naturally to the Father: Since His beginning at birth when Christ His Firstborn separated from His Body full of life like Himself. Love describes the attitude of the Father towards Christ His Firstborn Son among innumerable sons. It is the name given to the Father's attitude of earnest beneficent interest for the well-being of Christ His beloved Son. This warm affection or feeling in the Father, makes Him always seek the welfare and promotion of His Firstborn Son. This is the same warm affection humans also feel, towards loved ones: But that of the Father is to

a much greater degree. The Everlasting Father's warm feelings towards Christ the Lord, which the universe calls 'love,' is understandable. Remember that the Father existed alone in the pitch-black cloudiness He is wrapped in for the eternal past. Now, the Everlasting Father is no longer alone! Instead, He has two unique Offspring, the Holy Spirit and Christ the Lord, existing with Him in the pitch-black oily-like cloudiness! This intense warm affection that came naturally, fills the Everlasting Father with joy and laughter every time He looks on His tender Firstborn Son. As the Son said, "I was daily His delight" (Proverbs 8:30). Ever-expanding and passionate generosity summarizes the expression of this natural love the Father has for His Son. An expression of love, human parents understand and have for their children: Except that it is to a much greater degree with the Everlasting Father. Generous love for His Son, continuously expressed in Words and Deeds.

In words, including by the Names, the Everlasting Father affectionately calls His Firstborn Son. Like, "My Beloved Son with whom I am very pleased" and "My Chosen One

in whom My soul delights” (Isaiah 42:1; Matthew 12:18, 3:17; Proverbs 8:30). By these Names originating from deep warm affection,



the generous love of the Everlasting Father for Christ His Firstborn can be measured. Firstly, is the evidence of satisfaction and a sigh of relief. It is like a happy human father is, the day he first sees his firstborn child. This is evidence before everyone, of the father’s fertility and manhood. As He looks at Christ His Firstborn, the Everlasting Father is satisfied and relieved to see His fruitfulness and prowess demonstrated. Secondly, is the evidence of celebration. At last, the arrival of the Offspring Who will perform His pre-creation decision and pleasure: To have innumerable holy sons through whom the Everlasting Father will fill the entire universe with Himself, and be the everything in it (John 4:34). For this reason, also, the Everlasting Father loves His Firstborn Son tenderly and firmly. Firmly meaning, will never allow Him to go astray. Thirdly, the evidence of fulfillment and success. Christ His Firstborn had learned very well until He had

become exactly like His Father. Original like His Father in nature by mode of His birth, His Firstborn has also grown to be like His Father in knowledge, stature, and performance (John 14:8-10). This pleased the Everlasting Father very well because this is the Pattern for the innumerable sons He dreamt to have. Now His innumerable holy sons are ready to be born and nursed to maturity. Christ is evidence that everything is going well.

The Father's love is also expressed in deeds, like in appointment and creation. Firstly, the evidence of appointing Christ His Firstborn as Heir of all things (Hebrews 1:2). Like a human Father has an heir who will inherit everything when he dies. Except that the Everlasting Father lives forever, and can never die. Amen. But a generous warm affection the Everlasting Father has for Christ His Firstborn and Heir: Therefore, secondly, the evidence of creating the heavens and the earth with everything in them all with, by, and for His Firstborn (John 3:35). Then thirdly, the evidence of loving to share His attention, glory, and worship with His Firstborn and Spirit: Although never with anyone else, or idol

(Isaiah 42:8). Fourthly, and most profound evidence of His generous love, is the appointment of the Lord Holy Spirit as His Anchor. For this reason, the Holy Spirit only does what Christ the Governor says, as He works to accomplish all the Everlasting Father desires to have.

The most exciting part for the Everlasting Father is that His Firstborn, like His Spirit, reciprocates His generous love. As I heard Christ the Firstborn and Lord say to a man one day, "You love Me, and I love you: This is all that matters." This reciprocal love of Christ the Lord for His Father is rooted in His knowledge of who the Father is: And in His understanding of the warm and generous affection of the Father Who shows His Firstborn all things that He does (John 14:12). This reciprocal warm affection and feelings Christ has for His Father, whom He also loves generously, is the root of why Christ did what He did. And will do whatever it takes to accomplish everything the Everlasting Father desires, and wants to be accomplished.

## Chapter 4

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### *The Examination*

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It is widely known that when the Everlasting Father created mankind by His Spirit and Son, God created them male and female. God's intent for creating them male and female is so they multiply into the innumerable holy sons resembling Christ the Firstborn. As it is written in Scripture, “She took another fruit and ate: Then she gave the fruit to her husband, and he too ate.”



A million devils could do them no harm, as long as they continue to learn under the protection of innocent obedience. But now

that they have believed the devil's lie, they have become like one of the fallen angels who sinned without a tempter! Man must now run the race to holiness, with cunning and violent devils standing by their side desiring to have them all. Mankind must overcome the kingdom of devils exerting all their ingenuity to keep man bound to the sin and death the devils bring. Therefore God said, "The day you eat of it, you shall die." Everywhere you find people in the world, their unseen enemies are there to lure them away from obedience and glory prepared for them since the foundation of the world. By choosing to listen to devils, they come under the influence of disguised demons until they share the same cunning and violent nature. The result is the hard-to-control products of disobedience that evolved. Products like the burden of fear, faulty decision-making processes, a guilty conscience, and self-condemnation. # Chapter 6

The next checkpoint would quickly block the road, as soon as the vehicle drove away from the previous one! Each checkpoint asked for a bribe from every vehicle before they are allowed to drive through. The red-eyed driver groaned. "How much does this driver earn, that every of the more than 50 checkpoints on the highway demands a bribe?" I asked one of the officers. Who dared question their lucrative highway business? The officer was taken aback, as the sound of an approaching

siren announced the arrival of a high-ranking official. I watched as the blockades were removed one after the other for the high-ranking official to drive through without hindrance. "There is no way these leaders do not know about the flagrant greed and corruption going on on the highway," I spoke as the vehicle disappear into the distance.



"They are the leaders behind this blatant corruption," the unhappy driver whispered. As the sound of the siren faded, the officer jolted everyone back to the issue at hand. "Give at least 1000, and begone," the officer ordered as if it was a right. "How do you expect this driver to give so much at every checkpoint?" I retorted. The officer was ready this time, "Well, I have time. It is you who will soon start begging me." He did not bother to veil the threat, as he strolled back into the booth with a deadpan facial expression. "False accusations for fabricated crimes like a suspected terrorist, drug peddler, smuggler, and ritualist, are widespread here," a passenger whispered. Nowhere else have I seen lawless greed and corruption on full display, like that happening at that international border! Uncontrolled lust and love for money have yielded flagrant disregard for existing good laws and privileges, for personal enrichment. One could still hear the lies of that ancient devil in the Garden of Eden, “You will not die if you break God’s laws. Instead, you will become like

God.” Luring listening leaders, officials, and the world to continue breaking God’s good laws. Resulting in weakened public institutions and society, and an environment conducive to crimes by emboldened criminals. This combination has brought untold suffering and death to whole populations and nations for ages! Lured and spurred on by greedy and corrupt devils, those law enforcement officials for example believe they are doing the right thing. When, in fact, their actions bring suffering and death to the masses! The mystery of sin is when people believe they are right and are doing the right thing, when in fact their actions bring harm to others (Proverbs 14:12; Psalm 2:1)! His repeated warnings to not continue in lawlessness or disobedience called sin. But the world, like those law enforcement officials, is not listening!!! And the Everlasting God, Owner of the heavens and earth, is very angry with lawlessness because of the suffering and death



it brings to His people and His world. He is angry with the wicked, every day (Psalm 24:1, 7:11). Consequently,

the Everlasting God vowed to punish the nations for their lawlessness called sin. As a result, has set aside a terrible Day of Judgement when He will adequately reward everyone according to their works (Isaiah 13:1-14; Jeremiah 25:12): And also prepared an unspeakably horrible and cursed place of eternal torment called hell. Prepared primarily for the lawless devils, and for every human who continues in lawlessness till the end like the devils (Matthew 25:41). It may seem practical to keep destroying mankind as they sin, as happened with the first world. # Chapter 9

# Chapter 10

But today, now, commands everyone everywhere to be saved" (Acts 17:30). It is now mandatory for all sinners to turn away from sin! If sin is eternally overlooked, then likely one devil after another will arise in the eternal future. Meaning that the cunning and violent nature of sin, accompanied by suffering and death, will remain forever! "I do not want that," the Sovereign God declares. Neither do the innumerable holy sons of God want sin to continue forever. When the present age is over, may transgressions and sin with the curses they bring, never reoccur in all of eternity? Amen.

Obedience is the law for running with God, and His instructions are the way to be made holy to enter and have eternal life. As Christ said, "Your word is eternal life." Without obeying His laws and instructions, it would be impossible to achieve His desire to have a family of innumerable holy sons to dwell with forever. Therefore the Everlasting Father said,

“Heaven is My Throne, and the earth My Footstool: So what house can you build for Me? But this is what I want, people with lowly and meek hearts, with humble and contrite spirits, who tremble at My Word” (Isaiah 66:1-2). Like human fathers, except to a much greater degree, how Father God loves it when His children obey His words and run errands for Him! It is His pleasure and gain, as He daily loads them with generous benefits, abundant blessings, and pleasures forevermore. The decree that the end of sin is death, is so that all creation recognizes the seriousness with which the Everlasting Father views sin. His intent is so that it never reoccurs throughout eternity to come. And all creation rejoices about that.

Suddenly, the Voice of the Eternal God filled the universe as the waters cover the sea, “Whom shall I send; and who will go for Us?” Everyone everywhere became silent because without the shedding of blood there can be no atonement for sin. But whose blood will it be? Can it be any of the angels in heaven: the living creatures, archangels, cherubs, seraphs, or any of the innumerable guardian and ministering angels? The savior of mankind could never be

an angel since none was qualified or found worthy to even open the Book (Revelation 5:3-4). Perhaps at the command of God, an angel would step forward and be made flesh and blood to shed his atoning blood for the sins of the world. But the seriousness of how the Everlasting Father views sin would still be under question. The debate would continue forever, even if one angel died for every one thousand sinners. Then also, sin would have to continue forever, at one angel per thousand or a thousand angels for every sinner. No! That would not be enough!

Perhaps the blood of innocent Adam would have been enough to atone for the sins of his wife Eve. That is if he had thought about that! Adam instead joined his wife in sin, and that was the end of the matter! Maybe someone after Adam may knowingly or unknowingly die for a righteous person, or a parent may instinctively die for a child: But scarcely will one sinner deliberately agree to die for another! Maybe the seriousness of how the Everlasting Father views sin can be evident if all the remaining human beings were to die for only one sinner. Can the blood of one sinner

atone for the sins of another? Meaning that, can a dirty cloth be washed clean by even an ocean of dirty water? No!

But still, man the sinner boldly replied to the invitation, 'who will go for Us?' "Here I am, send me," the prophets replied (Isaiah



6:8). "Go then," the benevolent Eternal God approved rather than rebuke. 'Go and prepare the people for the arrival of the Lord. Point them to the holy ways of God, until the Savior comes to do what He alone can do. To Him shall all flesh come, and be saved' (Psalm 65:2; Joel 2:32; Acts 2:21; Romans 10:13). In response, the prophets and a multitude of people went about singing, praising, praying, and conducting diverse ministrations to point the world to the ways of God: And of the soon arrival of the Saviour.

What about the blood of the whitest and cleanest sheep and goats in the flock? It all started when the Everlasting God slaughtered the first animal in the Garden of Eden, to cloth Adam and his wife Eve. As humans began multiplying on earth, men soon began

slaughtering animals also as sacrifices to idol gods! Rather than allow His people to adopt this heathen practice, the Lord God commanded His people to sacrifice the animals to Him instead as atonement for their sins. The attitude of obedience, to sacrifice the best among the flock, was the honor done to God: For which reason God Almighty temporarily accepted the imperfect blood of animals as atonement for sin. For this attitude of obedience, the Lord God accepted Abel's sacrifice but rejected Cains'. Like the Law written on the Tablet of Stones, animal sacrifice for sin was the imperfect alternative until the perfect sacrifice is revealed. But it was not enough to cleanse sin! 'Simply slaughter more animals every time I sin,' became the way of the people. Rather than 'go and sin no more,' the people of God continued in sin, sometimes with impunity! The thriving business of animal rearing made sure there were enough animals to sacrifice for sin. Even the high priest among the people was not left out in the frenzy of animal sacrifice. The high priest would slaughter an animal for himself every year before he could minister to the

people! And the people slaughtered more animals as a sacrifice for the sin they kept on committing! King Solomon slaughtered 22,000 cattle and 120,000 sheep the day he dedicated the Jerusalem Temple to God in heaven (2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 7:5)! There was not enough space in the Temple for all the animals and sacrifices, and priests were crying for assistance everywhere! The outcome of all these animal sacrifices is that the people would not listen to the prophets telling them what the Lord God wants. The prophets cried, “The Lord God desires obedience, not sacrifices. To obey is better than sacrifices, and to heed is better than the fat of rams” (1<sup>st</sup> Samuel 15:22; Matthew 12:7)! But no one listened to the frustrated prophets, neither did they turn away from their evil ways! This practice of animal sacrifice continued until the Lord God confirmed, “ I have had enough of your sacrifices. I am sick of them. Obey My Voice” (Isaiah 1:11-17; Hosea 6:6; Amos 5:21-25). The Everlasting Father prefers to be obeyed so all attain glory prepared for





mankind, not empty sacrifices. That was what the blood of those animals was, empty! If the blood of animals cannot even take away sin (Hebrews 10:4), how then can it clear the conscience of sin? Can the blood of animals, therefore, make sinners holy and dwell forever with God? Absolutely, no!

As Scripture says, “The end will come when Christ will turn over everything to the Everlasting Father God. When all things are under His authority, the Son will put Himself under Father God’s authority: So that Father God who gave His Son authority over all things will be utterly supreme over everything everywhere.” (1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 15:24-28). The Everlasting Father is therefore sacred and set apart from all things. Better we all perish, many times over, than for the Everlasting Father to need to go Himself to atone for the sins of the world. But the Father and His Firstborn Son are the same.

From where He sat in the Presence of His Father and God, Christ the Firstborn already knew it had to be Him. Or else, sin will keep re-occurring and never atoned for: A thing His beloved Father does not want. His Father’s

desire to have innumerable holy sons will never be accomplished: And mankind He delights in will perish forever. Christ the Firstborn Himself had read the Books prepared before the foundation of the world. Only Christ can do what the first Adam could not do: And no angel, mankind, or animals can do. As the Firstborn Son of God looked on from His place, it was clear to Him that it had to be Him. As He looked on the Face of His Father, it was clear to Him also that this is what the Father wanted and planned for, even before creation began. That is exactly how severely the Everlasting Father views sin. A truth that will not be hidden from anyone for eternity. There will now be evidence of measuring the seriousness with which the Everlasting Father views sin. His Blood would surely be more than enough to atone for the sins of the world and all sinners forever. First because of His unique birth directly out of the His Father's Body: Therefore, for Christ to offer Himself as the sacrifice is tantamount to the Father offering Himself! This is His beloved Firstborn!! Secondly, all heavens and earth including mankind were created through, by, and for

Christ. Therefore, just as the life of the Sculptor is more important than that of all the sculptures put together, present and future, so is the Life of Christ to all humans.



Besides, it is as already written in the Books, before creation began that Christ the Savior will come to atone for the sins of the world, according to the will of the Everlasting Father. That He must atone for the sins of the world before He can enter His Glory as King of kings and Lord of lords. As Scripture says, "Although He shares the same nature with His Father and Spirit, yet He did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped. Instead, He humbled Himself to death on the Cross. Therefore it pleased the Everlasting Father to highly exalt Him: That at His Name every knee must bow, and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of the Everlasting Father." (Philippians 2:11)

Consequently, the lesson of obedience today is this: Everyone who believes why Christ came into the world, will prove their faith by obeying His words that lead to eternal life. But

anyone who does not obey the commands of Christ the Lord is a hypocrite and an unbeliever: Such will perish because of sin. This is the Law of Obedience acceptable to the Everlasting Father.

# Chapter 11

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## *Why He Came*

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It is to fulfill what was written by the Everlasting Father in the Books, that Christ His Firstborn must go down to earth: To *point* and *open* the good way, so men learn to do good instead of evil. This is why the Lamb of God had to come into the world (Matthew 26:53). The time came for the Firstborn to descend to earth on the Everlasting Father's errand! Christ stood to His Feet, as angels ascended and descended announcing His arrival to mankind on earth below. He spoke to His Father, "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a Body You have prepared for Me." With that, the Firstborn committed Himself into the Hands of

His Father to be conceived by the Holy Spirit in the womb of a virgin woman. When He became conscious of Himself in the flesh the Lord said, "Look. Here I am. As it is written about Me. I have come to do Your will" (Hebrews 10:5-7; John 4:34). Been found in the flesh, He grew in knowledge and stature. As the Holy Spirit, His Anchor testifies, "He knew exactly what He was sent to do." Christ the Lamb of God came to *point* mankind to their Father and God and to *open* the way for each human to get to the Heavenly Father.

## POINT THE WAY

In pointing the way before opening it, the Lamb of God had to *first* take the examination that Adam failed. Christ came to reverse Adam's error that brought sin and death into the world. Therefore He was tempted in every way. But unlike Adam, the Lord did not sin and neither did He join humanity in sin as Adam did with Eve. The Lord is therefore eminently qualified and able to



justify every sinner who puts their trust in Him. Since Christ knows every human frailty since He became human, He also understands the peculiarities and challenges that come with every temptation. Therefore, the Lord can sympathize, represent, and help them in their times of need. By reversing Adam's error and passing the examination Adam failed, Christ revealed to man how to always make the right decisions: How to overcome all the wiles of the devil, and how to receive anything we ask from the Heavenly Father. In making the right decisions Christ said, "The Son of Man does nothing by Himself, but as He sees and hears from the Everlasting Father." Therefore His judgments are always true and correct because He does not seek His own glory but that of the Father who sent Him (John 5:19, 8:16).

To overcome all the tricks and deceits of the devils, Christ the Lord said, "Let My word abide in you." Meaning that it is the Word of God that every human spirit needs to speak and obey. This way only, extinguish any fiery dart of the devil that brings including the burden of fear, a guilty conscience, and self-condemnation. Things that stand in the way of

faith in the Word and promises of God, without which no one can receive anything they ask from God (John 15:7; Matthew 4:4). Christ the Teacher is counseling everyone to study to increase the level of His word in themselves, and so become men and women of the Word. So that we know all that the Lord has given to us because of what Christ did: And receive anything we ask from the Everlasting Father simply by citing what Christ did and said.

*Secondly*, Christ came to bring understanding about who the Everlasting Father is. He went about teaching to reveal the good and holy ways and deep love of the Heavenly Father: Including His decisions, His goals, His priorities, and His likes and dislikes. So mankind can find why God is good, and be willing to run the Christian race to the top where God is waiting for His innumerable holy sons. Sons who willingly walk in the way of peace and righteousness like the Everlasting Father through Christ the Lamb. Therefore Christ concluded, "Be perfect as your Father in heaven is perfect." *Thirdly*, by exposing the truth about lawlessness and its consequences, Christ the Lord came to expose and overturn



the works of evil. Christ began to demonstrate to mankind how to cast out devils, and heal all manner of diseases and afflictions, with a word. This way, Christ demonstrated to man how easy it is to overturn the works of darkness and evil. The Lord said, "Believe in Me: And you will do greater works than Me." Meaning, honor Christ enough to trust Him to answer when we call for help. In the process, the Lord pointed the way to escape bondage to sin and death in eternal torment in hell. "Go, and sin no more," the Lord concluded.

## OPEN THE WAY

The time came for the Lord to suffer and die for the sins of the world. "No one takes My life from Me. I give it up willingly. I have the power to give it up, and the power to receive it back again. This command I received from My Father" Christ the Lord said (John 10:18). As He went to the Cross, it was clear that the Lord willingly gave Himself to die on the Cross of



Calvary. Christ willingly died to shed His atoning Blood, for the sins of the world. “Do you not know that I can ask the Father, and He will send legions of angels,” the Lord said (Matthew 26:53). That was after the Lord had asked the Everlasting Father in prayer to take away the cup of suffering and death! But the Father did not because the right to give and take His Life back again had already been granted. It was both to teach His Firstborn the lesson of obedience, and to fulfill the Scripture that the Father did that. Sure now that the Everlasting Father would not change His Mind, but that the sins of the world be atoned for by the only One who can, Christ humbled Himself and obeyed His Father until death. He willingly gave Himself to suffer and be scourged until crucified on that gruesome Cross of Calvary.

Christ came and died to restore the broken relationship and hostilities that came between faithless sinners mankind has become, and the Creator. Offering His crushed Body and Blood, on the Altar before the Father, justified the Father’s desire to pardon the iniquities of repentant sinners: While completely demonstrating the seriousness with which the

Everlasting Father views sin. This way, the Lamb of God glorified the Father for all eternity with His broken Body and shed Blood. For this, the Everlasting Father is very grateful to His obedient Firstborn and has spared nothing to demonstrate His gratitude. Even saying to His Firstborn, "Your Throne, O God, is forever and ever." And all mankind is also grateful to the Firstborn saying "Salvation belongs to our God who seats on the Throne, and to the Lamb" (Ezekiel 22:30; Hebrews 1:8; Revelation 7:9-11). In this way also, with His broken Body and shed Blood, Christ abundantly demonstrated the truth that the Everlasting Father loves mankind deeply. The very thing Christ had said all along, that the Father Himself loves mankind and will abundantly pardon even the vilest offender who repents and comes to Him through Christ the Lamb (John 3:16, 15:9). One thing is sure, nothing and no one can stand in the way of anyone who comes to know and believe the deep and measurable love of God for man. Like throwing away a disease, so anyone who understands the truth about the Father's love will discard the evil and everything associated with Satan. This way,

Christ continues to overturn and destroy the devil and his works in the hearts and consciences of mankind: Triggering also a hunger among men who understand, to return home to the Everlasting Father waiting to receive us. This reveals why the Almighty is pleased when His servants among men teach His holy ways and deep love.

It becomes evident too that Christ came to destroy the works of the primordial piercing serpent, Satan the tempter to sin and evil. True, it did not please the Firstborn to save the devils who sinned in heaven without a tempter. Yet His wonderful works still demonstrate the deep love of the Everlasting Father for the holy faithful angels. How? By revealing the goodness of the Everlasting Father with His Words and Blood of atonement for the sins of mankind, even the angels realize the seriousness with which the Father views evil. This way, Christ destroyed the horrendous lies of the devil told during his campaigns promoting rebellion and evil in heaven and on earth. The angels now know the



cunning and violent nature and works of evil: And the revelation of the goodness of the Everlasting Father unfolding before them on earth below. As they observe the suffering Firstborn on the Cross, it is no longer in doubt the seriousness with which God views sin that began with an angel. Add the knowledge of God's goodness, and the knowledge of the eternal doom into which those fallen angels have entered: I am not too sure any angel would for eternity ever contemplate rebellion again.

Every creature in heaven or earth, not only understands the seriousness with which the Everlasting Father views sin; but also understands the determination of the Firstborn to destroy sin and rebellion such that it would never reoccur in the eternal future. And that is also why Christ came and did what He did.

## Chapter 12

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### *Released Power*

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Sitting in the Church meeting hall that day, I was praying and contemplating why the thick dark clouds of life persisted. “Why Lord?” I respectfully asked over and over again. A believer and indeed a bondservant of Christ. Not only do I know what the Christian race is, but I am also teaching and running the race to the top! Yes, I am a church pastor: The senior pastor!! What shall I preach or tell the people? How shall I explain the hard and persistent delays, unanswered prayers, and persecutions that I was enduring! Besides, the Lord had sent me on an errand and I was on it! I am a servant of the Almighty! These were the many thoughts in my confused to

perplexed heart, as I wondered why the cloud was so dark around me. Being a redeemed servant of God did not exempt me from suffering the consequences of my sins. An anointed servant of God, for that matter! As Scripture says, “And it shall come to pass in that day that his burden shall be taken from off his shoulder and the yoke from off his neck. And the yoke shall be broken because of the anointing” (Isaiah 10:27). So, there I was in the Church hall praying in tongues and praying with my knowledge. Now I know that it is not because of anything a man says or does that God answers prayers since we cannot even pray as we should. Christ came so that we can ask the Everlasting Father whatever we want in His Name and according to His will, and our prayers will be answered. It is all because of what Christ did.

The Lord’s response to my prayer that day did not happen like thunder and lightning, or like an earthquake: Instead, it was gentle and peaceful. I suddenly became aware of the Presence of the Holy Spirit sitting by my side on His Throne in the Pillar of fire. Strangely, I did not feel any alarm or surprise in myself. It

appeared perfectly normal! I knew the Lord was always present except that now it pleased the Lord to allow me to see Him sitting by my side. As the Lord looked at something ahead of me, I was exceedingly content just to look at Him. Nothing should stop the eaglet from expressing excitement at seeing the Eagle. Nothing in this world would have made me stop enjoying the pleasant fragrance and security of the presence of God, in the dark clouds with me. Until the Lord pointed and said, "Look!" I turned to follow the direction of the Lord's thick and heavy pointed finger. Granted to see through the wall of the multi-purpose conference hall, the church hall, I saw the well-known big tree standing by my house on the farm. But underneath the tree, yet it could have been the same size as the big tree, was a reptile of a sought. The primordial reptilian demon creature in appearance like a crocodile freely moved around the house and the big tree with a sinister glee on its reptilian face. Up and down the demon spirit went until it stood like a man near the big tree! Then the Holy





Spirit said, "That is the demon troubling you." That was the demon behind the excruciating delays? The demon destroying my farm's palm trees and legume crops, leaving me wondering over the years why the harvests are poor? And even when we managed to produce in that harsh environment where access to credit was absent, we could not sell food products in the market to justify further production! Without access to credit, and perhaps lacking in creativity too, the farm did not have any post-harvest storage facility or food processing capacity. One year we could not sell our cassava and maize products: And the farm did not recover even the cost of transporting the food harvest to the market that year. Since cassava tubers and maize cobs are perishable products, the farm had to donate the entire harvest that year to orphanages and vulnerable people's homes. Not bad. But the farm needed to grow! There under the big tree, in broad daylight, was the demon spirit troubling me? That is the creature invisible to the human eyes troubling us by interfering with our spiritual and physical growth and development? The offending creature had a

sinister smirk of satisfaction on its ugly reptilian face. Invisible to the human eyes, these cunning evil demons are everywhere in the world, making fun of ignorant mankind as they come to kill, steal or destroy. They do not mind being called Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs), or whatever other names men choose, it is part of the fun. But how can mankind fight the enemy they cannot see? Christ the Lamb of God came to give mankind the power to fight and defeat these 'UFOs.' Which is why it is their highest and most desperate strategy to lure mankind away from involving Christ the Lord in personal and global development!

At that moment, the Power of God also in the world, who comes because of what Christ did spoke again with a level of severity, "Now CAST IT OUT." I pointed my finger at the demon as the Lord did and cried out, "You unclean spirit, in Jesus' Name I cast you out." I only obeyed the Lord's command, because that was not a very powerful long prayer. Proving that obedience is the key to any breakthrough! The explosive power came from obeying the Lord's



command. No wonder the one goal in the Church is, to seek and obey the voice of the Lord. If the Church is weak in the world, as some people say, it is for this reason. Once the command comes after seeking the Lord in prayers, and we obey the command, the power of God attends to perform His command! I simply obeyed what the Lord commanded me to do, and the explosive power of God did the rest. I was granted to see what happened next. The Lord flicked one of His thick and heavy strong-looking fingers: Just like a human would flick away an offending insect from off his working table. The Lord will always leave that window open for man to exercise their faith in Him: Although I was not granted to see the wretched reptilian demon tumble into outer darkness, I am sure that is what happened: Because I am still laughing and rejoicing at the victory that followed since that day. But actually, the victory is from the Lord, and for the Lord alone to give. I am sure the sinister smirk on the demon's face disappeared as the power of God dispatched the doomed demon into outer darkness! That was very nice! That day, Christ displayed His power to use the weak

and blind to confound the strong who say they know and see. Christ used one who called to Him for help, to break the yoke of bondage to cunning and violent demons! Suddenly, every believer held captive by Satan the devil now has the power to forcefully break the chains of bondage and eject Satan! Captives of hard-to-deal-with situations and circumstances can now break free from the stranglehold of invisible demons. The world can now be set free from bondage to sin and death, with its manifold consequences like widening insecurity. Today, believers in what Christ did can now use the power of God to perform miracles and to do the things that were formally impossible for them to do. So the weak can say 'I am strong.' This is why Christ came and did what He did. Christ came into the world to release Holy Spirit His Power and Anchor, so everyone and the world who seek and obey the Holy Spirit will overcome personal and global challenges all caused by cunning and violent devils. As Christ, the Lord, said, "In the world, you shall have tribulations; but be of good cheer I have



overcome the world. In My name, they shall cast out demons, and they will be forced to obey” (John 16:33; Mark 16:17). Very importantly, now mankind has the right to exercise the power to cast out devils!!!

Things improved on the farm from that day. But there are still many victories to be won in this walk through life. Unlike in the past, we now know what happened: With why and how the victories come in all circumstances. Make casting out devils a daily practice! In the personal, family, community, national and global affairs; believe what Christ did and cast out devils! Do it as often as you can, the power of God is not tired of confirming the reason why Christ came into the world. Cast out devils as often as one observes a questionable development; and especially as the Holy Spirit reveals. As the Holy Spirit said, “Draw close and stay close to God.” Remain in the safety of the Presence of the Holy Spirit! God’s power is not to be used except for the purpose for which it is given. As Christ, the Lord said, “Use My power. But you must first tell Me what you want to use it for: Or else He will not respond to you.” The Holy Spirit repeats over and over

again, “I have told you what to do in this present generation: Show kindness and cast out demons.” Do it! Start doing it! Since the battle belongs to the Lord, speak the word of casting them out; but focus on the work He has given you to do. Except as the Lord commands, do not waste your time, fighting devils. “Leave them for us,” the angels encamped around believers who fear God, admonish. Focus on the work Christ has given you, but obey the command of the Holy Spirit to cast out devils. It is with a word as Christ demonstrated, as our Lord went about pointing mankind to the goodness of the Everlasting Father.

Christ the Lamb of God came to release the Power of God into the lives of everyone who believes in Him. Before the coming of the Messiah, the Holy Spirit the Power of God performed special and temporal assignments on earth. But after Christ did what He did, and His atoning Blood was shed, the Spirit of Might has been permanently released to men to achieve all things. As Christ said, “If you believe in Me, I will ask the Everlasting Father and He will give you the Holy Spirit to dwell with you forever” (John 14:16). And that is what

happened. Today, anyone who believes in what Christ did to save sinners, will ask for the Holy Spirit and will receive the Best Gift in the world. To fulfill what Christ the Lord said again, "He is in you, as He is in Me." What our Lord the Holy Spirit will do in the lives of all who allow the Spirit of God to enter has been provided in detail in another book, 'The Holy Spirit' (*see list of references*). The Holy Spirit is the Power of God every human need to be sanctified or nurtured to become holy by a righteous character like Christ. Whether the power to cast out devils and the power to perform the miracle of character change: One lesson resounds in all, 'obey God.' That summarizes why Christ came. He came to give mankind a new and fresh start to do just that, "Obey My Voice."

# Chapter 13

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## *Welcome Home*

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Christ came into the world to point and open the way for mankind to follow to reach the Everlasting Father at the top of the Christian race. By leaving the glory Christ had with the Father before the foundation of the world (John 17:5), Christ descended to earth with an agenda to save and heal mankind. To restore mankind to their original purpose for creation, which is to be the innumerable holy sons the Everlasting Father desires to have and dwell with forever. In the *Holy place* on earth in which Christ went about doing good, the Lord pointed mankind to the Holy Father with Words accompanied by signs and wonders. Anchored by the Holy Spirit,



Christ went forward to confront the Evil in the world. Then He willingly gave Himself to suffer and die at the hands of His enemies. After three days in the grave, Christ was resurrected from the grave and ascended back to glory with His Everlasting Father and God.

This way, Christ opened the way mankind must follow to also ascend to glory forever with the Everlasting Father. "I am the way, the truth, and the life: No one can get to the Father except through Me. Take up your cross and follow Me," Christ said. Since flesh and blood cannot inherit glory, neither can sin, Christ pointed the way to glory by His example. Dwelling in the shadow of death all life-long, each person must go in the direction from where Christ came. They must begin the race to glory at the place where Christ ended, which is at the Cross of Calvary: There receives pardon for sin because of the cleansing shed Blood of the Lamb of God. Thereafter, receive the gift of the Holy Spirit to come and finish the work God started in each person since birth into the world. The holy place of life in the Christian race to holiness is where the believer is willing and obedient to the leading of the

Holy Spirit. It is here in the holy place, Christ our Lord first walked in, that believers learn the lesson of life, which is obedience. Here, believers learn to seek and obey the voice of the Holy Spirit as Christ the Pioneer of our faith did, in words and deeds. "When the Holy Spirit comes, He will testify of Me by guiding you into all truth which I told you," Christ the Lamb of God said. This is the life of learning obedience that continues until man begins to approach the top of the race when they begin to see God clearer and clearer: Like a mountain climber approaching the top of the mountain. Christ came down the mountain to save mankind below, so mankind can climb up the mountain to the glory above. Christ came down from glory above into the shadow of death below, so mankind dwelling in the shadow of death below can climb up to glory above. Like going from west to east, so man can go from east to west. This is the Christian race to the top.



The door to glory opened when Christ died on the Cross so anyone who believes what

Christ did will receive the Holy Spirit the Lord who guides up the mountain to the glory above. As Christ said, "I am the door. The way, the truth, and the life. No one gets to the Father except through Me" (John 10:9-16, 14:6). The innumerable sons the Everlasting Father desires to have, are flowing through Christ the Door. Out of every nation, tribe, and tongue, on earth they are going home to the waiting Everlasting Father. As the redeemed are running the Christian race up the mountainside that is the holy place, still making mistakes like newborn babies learning to walk: Christ the Lamb of God continues to make intercession. Making intercessions with His broken Body and Blood saying, "Father forgive them because they do not know what they are doing." A thing the Everlasting Father is pleased to do, with the response, "Let them continue to come. Welcome home." And that was the vision I also saw of the scourged and broken Christ. He was interceding for me as I traveled that day from Nigeria to the Benin Republic, both countries in West Africa.

Not all the books in the world will contain all the reasons why Christ the Lamb of God did

what He did and His accomplishments from doing what He did. It is enough to keep in mind the main reason why: It is to ensure that the desire of the Eternal Father to have innumerable holy sons is accomplished. As the Everlasting Father said, "Surely, as I have planned so it will be: And as I have purposed so it will happen" (Isaiah 14:24). Christ died to save mankind, to make sure that the plan and purpose of the Everlasting Father happen. And it has happened, and is happening, and will continue to happen. Hallelujah!! This way Christ the Faithful and True servant of the Everlasting Father, came to demonstrate His eternal love for His Father and God under Whose generous love He dwells from everlasting to everlasting.
